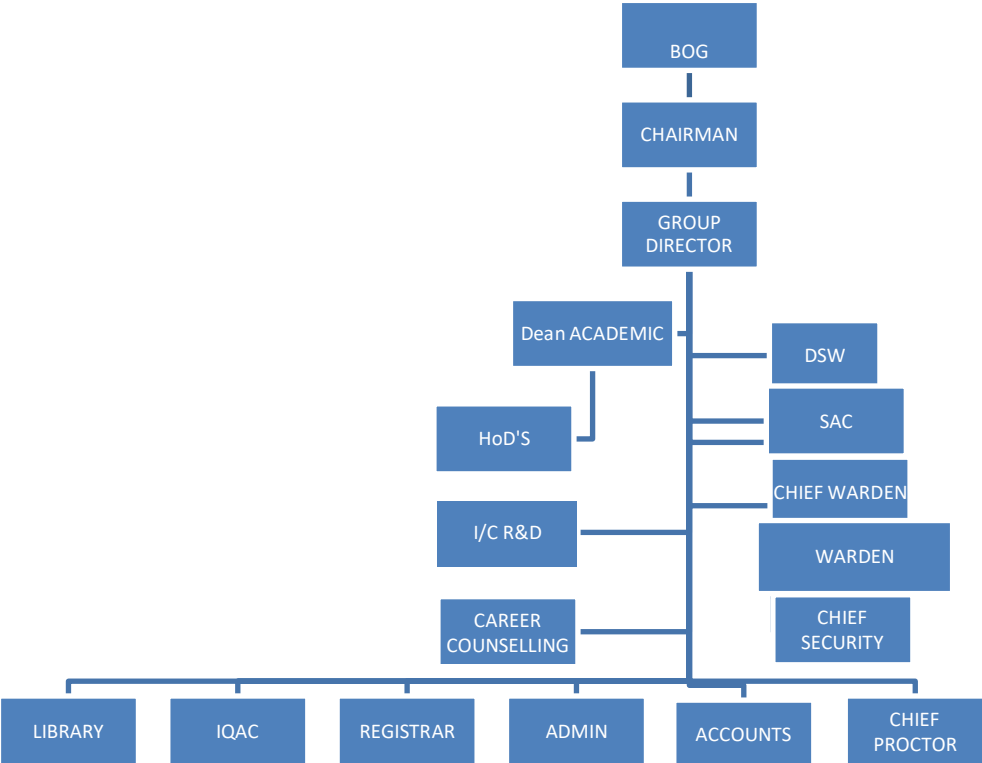

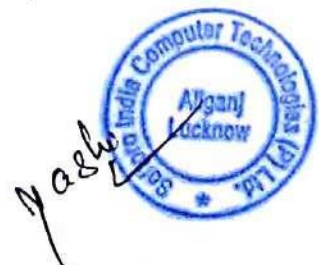

S.R Group of Institutions College of Engineering Management & Technology, Jhansi and Institute of Engineering and Technology, Bhagwant University, Ajmer recognize their strengths in research and education in one or more disciplines of science Engineering, Management and social sciences, and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic cooperation.

They therefore agree to establish a programme for academic cooperation in the areas of mutual interest, and in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum of understanding (MoU).

A. Objectives

The aim for this arrangement is to set up such an environment where the students can benefit from better education system through correspondence, shared interests, mutual benefits, and interactive sessions held by the two institutes. The objectives under this memorandum consists of ideas including:

- a) to exchange information on research and educational programmes
- b) to exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes
- c) to jointly organize short-term continuing education programmes on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- d) to jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- e) to jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- f) to exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students for limited periods of time for the purpose of education and /or research. S.R Group of Institutions College of Engineering Management & Technology, Jhansi and Institute of Engineering and Technology,

Bhagwant University, Ajmer further agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be separately determined and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation, etc.

B. Joint Sponsored Research, Development and Consulting

The S.R Group of Institutions College of Engineering Management & Technology, Jhansi and Institute of Engineering and Technology, Bhagwant University, Ajmer agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in research or development programmes. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between the two bodies.

C. Exchange of Faculty, Scientists and Staff

The two institutes agree to encourage collaboration between faculty and scientists from the two institutions. Specifically, institutions will encourage members of their faculties to undertake short visits to, or take up fixed-term visiting assignments at, each other's institution as per the existing norms. Terms and Conditions for each visit or an assignment, including those concerning stipend, travel, and housing, name of the concerned faculty member will be worked out between the institutes. Notwithstanding the above, the S.R Group of Institutions College of Engineering Management & Technology, Jhansi and Institute of Engineering and Technology, Bhagwant University, Ajmer will examine ways to identify financial resources to fund international travel by their faculty/scientists/students.

D. Student Exchange

The two institutes agree that student exchange will be guided by principles listed below. A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student, and from where he/she is expected to graduate.

A host institution refers to an institution that receives a student for a brief period to undertake a pre-determined programme of study or research.

- a) Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.
- b) An exchange student will continue to be treated as full-time student at his/her home institution.
- c) An exchange student will be considered as full-time "exchange" student at the host institution.
- d) His/her programme of study at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor identified by the host institution.

- e) The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module, award a letter grade or marks, and issue a letter to that effect.
- f) The home institution may award to the exchange student credits earned at a host institution, but only after the home institution has established correspondence between courses taken at the host institution vis-a-vis those offered at the home institution.
- g) If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the host institution will evaluate the exchange student's performance in the research, and issue a letter to that effect, together with a technical "report" of the research carried out.
- h) If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the home institution will take note of the performance evaluation and the technical report, and take steps in accordance with its own procedures.
- i) S.R Group of Institutions College of Engineering Management & Technology, Jhansi and Institute of Engineering and Technology, Bhagwant University, Ajmer agree on providing with suitable accommodation and living expenses for the student exchange.
- j) To avail travel expenses, students can apply for existing funding programs at their respective home universities.
- k) The exchange students will pay tuition and other fees at their home institution.

E. Exchange of Scientific and Technical Material

The two institutes will exchange information on research and educational programmes and teaching/learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes. Further, S.R Group of Institutions College of Engineering Management & Technology, Jhansi and Institute of Engineering and Technology, Bhagwant University, Ajmer agree to explore ways to share teaching/learning material, and other relevant literature, while respecting each other's intellectual property and other rights.

F. Joint Conferences, workshops, and short-term courses

The two institutes agree to conduct Joint Conferences, workshops, and short-term courses to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in such events. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between the S.R Group of Institutions College of Engineering Management & Technology, Jhansi and Institute of Engineering and Technology, Bhagwant University, Ajmer.

G. Intellectual Properties

S.R Group of Institutions College of Engineering Management & Technology, Jhansi and Institute of Engineering and Technology, Bhagwant University, Ajmer agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on a case-by-case basis, and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

H. Co-ordination

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf.

Further, a coordination committee, consisting of




1. It is mandatory to comply with all the provisions as given in APH 2023-24 (Chapter VI) and also in the 'Guidelines for Institutions Applying for Running Vocational Courses' uploaded at www.aicte-india.org/education/vocational-education
2. The institution will ensure that the minimum batch size of 10 students shall be maintained for each course.
3. The courses must be conducted as per the guidelines issued under SAMVAY (Skill Assessment Matrix for vertical advancement of Youth). Training under these courses must be aligned with the outcome at each level as prescribed under National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF).

It is mandatory to comply with all the essential requirements as given in APH 2023-24 (Appendix 6)

Important Instructions

1. The State Government/ UT/ Directorate of Technical Education/ Directorate of Medical Education shall ensure that 10% of reservation for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) as per the reservation policy for admission, operational from the Academic year 2019-20 is implemented without affecting the reservation percentages of SC/ ST/ OBC(NCL) / General. However, this would not be applicable in the case of Minority Institutions referred to the Clause (1) of Article 30 of Constitution of India. Such Institution shall be permitted to increase in annual permitted strength over a maximum period of two years.
2. The Institution offering courses earlier in the Regular Shift, First Shift, Second Shift/Part Time are now amalgamated as total intake and shall have to fulfil all facilities such as Infrastructure, Faculty and other requirements as per the norms specified in the Approval Process Handbook 2023-24 for the Total Approved Intake. Further, the Institutions Deemed to be Universities/ Institutions having Accreditation/ Autonomy status shall have to maintain the Faculty: Student ratio as specified in the Approval Process Handbook.
3. Strict compliance of Anti-Ragging Regulation, Establishment of Committee for SC/ ST, Establishment of Internal Committee (IC), Establishment of Online Grievance Redressal Mechanism, Barrier Free Built Environment for disabled and elderly persons, Fire and Safety Certificate should be maintained as per the provisions made in Approval Process Handbook and AICTE Regulation notified from time to time.
4. In case of any differences in content in this Computer generated Extension of Approval Letter, the content/information as approved by the Executive Council / General Council as available on the record of AICTE shall be final and binding.
5. As per the AICTE Notification dated 29.01.2014 and amended thereto, it shall be mandatory for each Technical Education Institution, University Department and Institution Deemed to be University imparting Technical Education to get accreditation (NBA) for at least 60% of the eligible courses in the next ONE (1) Years' time, otherwise EoA for the subsequent Academic Year (A.Y. 2024-25) shall not be issued by the Council.
6. Deemed to be University: Institutions Deemed to be Universities (Running Technical Education Programmes), it is mandatory to have AICTE approval from the Academic Year 2018-19 in compliance of the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 03-11-2017 passed in CA No.17869- 17870 /2017.
